FULL DEVELOPMENT OF ENVISIO DIGITAL HUB


The ENVISIO Digital Hub will serve as a comprehensive set of resources designed to support deaf youth in developing green entrepreneurial skills. It will include:

- Five training programmes covering topics like sustainable business models, ecobranding, financing, and supply chain management
- Augmented Reality (AR) case studies to enhance immersive learning
- PowerPoint presentations for blended learning sessions
- A Learning Framework Guide to support trainers and facilitators

All materials will be translated into the sign language of the participating countries Italy, Latvia, and Turkey, ensuring accessibility and inclusion. The content will also be available in English ang Greek language without sing-language interpretation.
